Driving Directions to Camp Burton **From Seattle:**

From I-5 take the West Seattle Bridge (exit 163), cross the bridge and follow signs to the Vashon Ferry. At the five way intersection the street will be Fauntleroy Ave. Veer to the left (Shell Station to the right) and continue past Lincoln Park. The ferry dock is at the south end of the park.

Purchase a round trip ticket to Vashon Island. When you dock at Vashon Island, you will exit the ferry and be on the Vashon Is. Highway. Follow this road about nine miles and along the way you will stop at 4 flashing-light intersections. At the 4th stop, turn left on to to SW Burton Dr. Follow for 1/3 mile to SW Bayview Dr. and turn right. Follow another 1/3 mile and you will see the entrance to Camp Burton on the left.
